The foregoing, having been considered by the Court, is hereby:

ORDER:

The court, having reviewed the requests, responses and objections, rules as follows:

Request #9: The objection of the plaintiff is sustained, without prejudice for the defendant to make a request more limited in time and subject matter.

Request #15: The objection of the plaintiff is sustained, without prejudice for the defendant to submit a request for a list of contracts limited in subject matter, asking for a description of the activities to be performed under each identified contract. The defendant would then have a subsequent right to ask for specific relevant documents or types of relevant documents relating to those contracts.

Request #16: The plaintiff's objection is sustained without prejudice for the defendant to ask for a list of such employees, if any, and a statement of their qualifications and experiences.

Request #17: Plaintiff's objection sustained subject to the same terms as Request #16.

Request #27: Plaintiff's objection is sustained. The request as propounded is overly broad and confusing.

Request #38: The plaintiff's objection is sustained. The request for all documents is overly broad. Any such request for such information should allow for the privacy and statutory rights of the employees.

Response #41: The objection of the plaintiff is granted, subject to the right of the defendant to ask for plaintiff to provide a calculation of its turnover rate for a specific period of time, together with an explanation of how it calculated said rate.

Response #42: Sustained as overly broad both as to duration and documentation. Defendant should consider asking for a list of employees whose employment terminated over a more limited and relevant time frame, not by name, and a brief statement of the stated grounds or reasons for termination, if known.
